INDIANAPOLIS, IN: How exciting is it when over twenty children receive the gift of mobility? Well you can find out on Saturday, **March 13 beginning at 2:00 PM** when The Greater Indy Friends Chapter of AMBUCS, in partnership with Ronald McDonald Charities of Central Indiana and the Danville, Illinois Chapter of AMBUCS conduct an AmTryke Open House in the **Atrium at Riley Hospital at 720 Barnhill Drive.**

The opportunity of enjoying the simple pleasure of riding a bicycle is often lost to children with disabilities. But, it doesn't have to be that way, because AMBUCS has a solution. The AmTryke therapeutic tricycle is designed for children with disabilities. A child can pedal the tricycle by using either hands or feet. There are several other adaptations that can be done when fitting a an AmTryke including frame size, frame positioning, seat selection, head rests, trunk support, knee separators, foot cups, handgrip placement and pedal size. This makes it ideal for children with a variety of special needs including Down syndrome, cerebral palsy, spina bifida, autism and other conditions that cause delays in motor and social development. **But most important they are fun to ride and offer the opportunity for inclusive play!**

Through a grant from the Ronald McDonald House Charities of Central Indiana and the Danville Chapter of AMBUCS the members of the Greater Indy Friends Chapter of AMBUCS will donate AmTrykes to over twenty children who have been evaluated and recommended for an AmTryke by therapists from Riley's and St. Vincent's Hospitals.

AMBUCS is a national not-for-profit public charity with over 125 chapters in 25 states. The approximately 5,000 members of AMBUCS conduct fund raising activities to purchase and donate AmTrykes to children with disabilities. Last year alone AMBUCS member donated over 2,5000 AmTrykes. The members of the new Greater Indy Friends Chapter of AMBUCS are rolling up their sleeves to help children with disabilities get moving!

The public is invited to attend the Open House that will be from 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Representatives of the Greater Indy Friends Chapter will be present to answer questions about the AmTryke and to explain how to become a member of AMBUCS.
